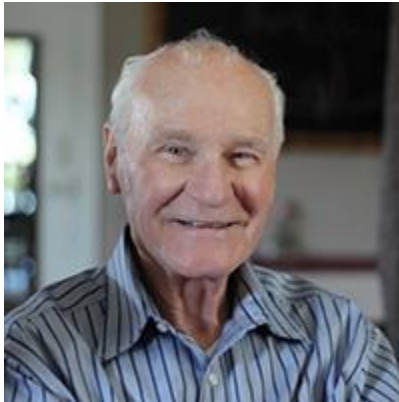


Obituary for Jim Doherty
