

If you are planning on running an in-school or introduction to Judo Program, please be aware of the following, as per the 2019 / 2020 Judo Fee Guides communicated prior to the season start:

In-School Programs:

- No fees per person
- During school hours only
- Teacher must be present (or be the instructor)
- Grading permitted, maximum orange belt
- No competition or similar activities (would need to register as a full member)
- No vote at AGM
- Participants must be registered in Trackie under the club of the sensei teaching the program
- **Requires a letter from the school approving the program** (identifying the days / hours / dates / instructor) **to be sent to Judo Nova Scotia**

Introduction to Judo Programs:

- \$10 fee per person
- **Requires official letter of permission from Judo Nova Scotia**
- Maximum 15 weeks, once per lifetime of participant
- No grading, white belt only, no competition or similar activities
- No vote at AGM
